MEETING MINUTES (#47, by L. Segal)

October 10, 2009

Meeting convened at 10 a.m.

Committee members drafted the content of a Cultural Council grant application due October 15 for an interpretative educational program for families with primary school-aged children titled "The River Comes out of Your Faucet" to be offered in conjunction with the annual Riverfest celebration held on a weekend in mid-June, 2010. There will be a guest presenter from Audubon with a live river animal (e.g. turtle or duck). Member Tom Sciacca will demonstrate the aquifer model so children can see the relationship between land use activities and the groundwater and aquifer below. A nearby alternative accessible location in the event of stormy weather was discussed (e.g. Russells lecture room, Public Safety Building Community Room, etc.).

WPC members voted to submit the application as drafted with attachments (required resumes, etc) and with language to be finalized by J. Riley and S. Greenbaum. (S. Greenbaum motion, L. Segal second, voted 3-0).

After completing the application, the meeting recessed at 11:15 a.m. to visit the historic Four Arch Bridge location proposed for this event to confirm adequate parking and staging areas.

Next meeting will be October 15, 2009. Birch Road MEPA FEIR comments are due October 23.
