DRAFT MEETING MINUTES (#100 by L. Segal)

June 29, 2011

Attendance: Sherre Greenbaum, Jennifer Riley, Tom Sciacca, Linda Segal, Kurt Tramosch
Location: Public Safety Building Community Room, 38 Cochituate Rd., Wayland, MA

Meeting convened at 9:10 a.m.

Wellhead Protection Plan: WPC consensus on distribution of a few hard copies of Plan, including one to Town Clerk and one to Library since BoPW issued press release that the Plan is out for public comment for BoPW July 25 meeting. Chairman will send email reminder and thanks to ConCom & BoH. WPC not copied on BoPW press release dissolving WPC nor on new advisory committee charge voted by BoPW on June 20. WPC received no feedback from BoPW, DPW, Selectmen, or water superintendent on content of the Plan presented to the BoPW on June 6, 2010. K. Tramosch reported to WPC from having attended BoPW/BoS June 20 meeting where WPC was on meeting agendas of both boards; no courtesy heads up to WPC had been provided. No comments were made about the Plan's content. Town Administrator Fred Turkington misinformed televised meeting about WPC's 2007 formation & charge, website incident last July, etc. J. Mishara misinformed the meeting that WPC submitted the Plan to DEP before the BoPW had seen it. F. Turkington had met with staff to discuss the Plan, without including WPC. Board members did not seem to recognize Kurt as a WPC committee member seated in the audience while they criticized the WPC. DPW Director continued criticism at subsequent BoPW meeting.

Minutes: J. Riley motioned, K. Tramosch seconded, voted 5-0 to approve WPC meeting minutes for June 6, 2011. Meeting #100 minutes will be submitted to the DPW office as draft (public record).

Public education: Not known if one-day summer town beach program for preschool children will occur. T. Sciacca reported submitting landscaper's bill for maintaining Mellen green to DPW Director, but not known if that bill has been paid. Grass is being cut too short. Consensus to restock WPC public education handouts on town hall lobby table.

Website: L. Segal reported no progress in completing WPC website. Last time pdf files (WPC docs, studies, reports, Historical Wayland Water Works docs, etc.) were sent to DPW office for posting on WPC website was April 29; still not posted. Helen Lewis working Wednesdays until she retires in late July.

Adjournment of 100th WPC meeting: T. Sciacca motioned, J. Riley seconded, meeting voted adjourned 5-0 ("sine die") at 10:15 a.m.
