

## WAYLAND WELLHEAD PROTECTION COMMITTEE

### MEETING MINUTES (#86, by L. Segal)

January 26, 2011

Attendance: Sherre Greenbaum, Jennifer Riley, Linda Segal, MassRWA B. Young (9:30 a.m.)  
Water Superintendent Mike Hatch (10 a.m.)

Location: Public Safety Bldg. Community Room, 38 Cochituate Rd., Wayland, MA

Meeting convened at 9:15 a.m.

**Wellhead Protection Plan:** B. Young explained how to create a snow shelf for safer storage: small depression a few inches into landscape, after snow season, scrape off accumulated salt/sand. WPC voted (S.G. motion, J.R. second) 3-0 to send Memo to Selectmen & S. Kadlik on snow storage safety. No word yet on BoH action re WPC sodium advisory Memo. Post advisory on town website? Ask T. Sciacca to follow up; meanwhile L. Segal to check with S. Calichman.

**Water Superintendent report:** M. Hatch reported Lincoln Town Manager responding on Zone II protection/best effort requirement. Needs map showing where Wayland Zone II & capture zone overlap into Lincoln for their town meeting. No word yet from Framingham or Sudbury. Another water main break on Rolling Lane.

**Wellhead Protection Plan:** Add action item re USTs into plan. GIS shows less than perfect state layer for pervious/impervious. Gravel roads are impervious by definition because they get compacted over time. Rooftops, roads, driveways, pools show up. Sidewalks may not. B. Young to email info to B. Decker. For each wellhead, WPP will include zone I map, capture zone map, zone II map w/residences in each, impervious surface map w/zone I and capture zone. B. Young needs photos from K. Tramosch, e.g. sand mining, beaver dams, SWQC broken septic, etc. Suggests CPA funds to stamp message at storm drains. Right of first refusal letter in zone I (too costly?). E. Brideau preparing list of inground pools in zone II. Public education needed re chlorine. WPC discussed other uses in zone II, e.g. nail salons, spas, animal keeping. Ask B. Decker for commercial uses in zone II (Economic Development Committee has maps). Agreed to get remaining info to B. Young in two weeks. DEP will want to see who has responsibility to implement action items in WPP. Estimate meet with BoPW with draft plan in late March. Hold public hearing last Wednesday in April, with required legal ad in Crier. After discussion about some redundancy, consensus remained to describe PSOC in each section & refer to greater details in appendix. Publish double-sided. L. Segal to send historical water works files from library & hazmat sites description to B. Young. Check w/T. Sciacca re sodium description.
