

The **Aquifer Protection District (APD)** is an overlay district composed of those land areas that provide recharge to a drinking water supply well. In Wayland the APD is comprised of the MassDEP-approved Zone IIs.

The district was so designated in Chapter 198 Section 16 of the Town Code in order to “preserve and maintain the existing and potential groundwater supplies, aquifers and recharge areas of the Town and to protect them from development or land use practices that would adversely affect their quality or quantity; preserve and protect present and potential sources of drinking water supply for the public health and safety; and conserve the water resources of the Town.”
