Gentlemen:

The Department of Public Health, in response to requests made in your behalf by Mr. G. P. Richardson, Superintendent of your Water Department, has considered the matter of the control of land around the proposed Riverview gravel-packed well to be located off Meadowview Road.

You have previously been advised relative to this matter in a communication from this Department dated August 18, 1966.

The Department of Public Health is informed that although takings were made by the town of Wayland on January 3, 1966, the government of the United States made takings of the same land to establish a wildlife refuge. However, the U.S. Government takings left to the town of Wayland water easements and rights presently now proposed for use. The Department is in receipt of a copy of a letter dated March 11, 1969 from the U. S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife, signed by Mr. Richard E. Griffith, Regional Director, and addressed to Mr. Richardson, which indicates that the Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife will not use the land in any manner that will affect the well or the quality of the water.

The Department of Public Health, therefore, hereby approves the land acquisition and control by the town of Wayland and the U.S. Government as meeting provisions 1 and 2 of the communication of August 18, 1966, subject to your board obtaining a written agreement from the Boston Edison Light Company, a copy of which must be submitted to this Department for its files, wherein they will agree not to use any herbicides or pesticides on their electric right of way without the prior written approval of this Department.
